SUMMARY OF VESSEL AND GEAR SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE
UNITED STATES PACIFIC COAST TRAWL FLEET, 1974

The 1974 United States Pacific Coast groundfish trawl fleet totalled 290 vessels, up 12% from the 259 vessels of record in 1973. Tonnage classes, by state, were:
