SUMMARY OF VESSEL AND GEAR SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE  
UNITED STATES PACIFIC COAST TRAWL FLEET, 1975

The 1975 United States Pacific Coast groundfish trawl fleet totalled 245 vessels, down 15.5% from the 290 vessels of record in 1974. Tonnage classes, by state were:
