SUMMARY OF VESSEL AND GEAR SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE
UNITED STATES PACIFIC COAST TRAWL FLEET, 1976

The 1976 United States Pacific Coast groundfish trawl fleet totalled 255 vessels, up 4.1% from the 245 vessels of record in 1975. Tonnage classes, by state were:
